

# MISSOURI YMCA YOUTH IN GOVERNMENT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE APPLICATION

## OVERVIEW

YIG offers financial assistance ranging from \$50 to \$175. **Applications are due to the YIG State Office by September 29, 2011.** Applications received after this date will be considered only if funding remains available. If an application is approved, the student's advisor will be notified of the remaining balance owed to YIG.

## SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

1. You and your parents must be in need of this financial assistance, without which you may not be able to participate in YIG.
2. Please familiarize your advisor of your financial circumstances and inform them that the State Office may be contacting them.
3. Applications will be reviewed by October 6, 2011. Decisions are based on this application and input from your advisor. Applications received after October 6, 2011 will not be considered.
4. Your advisor will be notified of a decision on October 7, 2011.
5. Your application must be signed by both you and your parent/guardian. Applications that do not have both signatures will not be considered.

**Please note that YIG has limited funds to allocate for financial assistance. We try to help as many students as possible with these funds, and allocate them in a fair manner. We ask that you be honest with the answers you provide to the questions below to enable us to make the best decisions in the allocation of funds.**
